## **BRAINSTORMING IDEAS:**

### Landscape:

Key Takeaway: Soften the hardscape with plantings to create a more inviting feel.

- Hanging Baskets on light poles to soften the streetscape.
- Farmer's Market Building is beautiful but surrounded by hardscape. Surround with plants and flowers.
- More seating on Courthouse Lawn.
- Add Pocket Parks
  - More greenery needed throughout streetscape the panorama highlighted just how much stark paving / hardscape we have.
- More outdoor seating could create pallet seating for outdoor movies.

#### Amenities:

Key Takeaway: People of all ages want to hang out downtown – day AND night!

- Restaurant (open at night)!
  - Classy Date Night Steakhouse / Speak Easy / Brewery Café
  - Take advantage of weekend events and soccer tourneys at CW Lewis stadium.
  - With Live Music!
- Coffee Shop
- Brewery!
  - PopUp Brewery potential at Federal Building if owner is open. Create outdoor dining area in front – potentially take in 2 parking spots with temporary pallets.
- Vendors
  - PopCorn near Movie Area
  - o PopUp Vendor Market (on Market!) in vacant DG space if possible.
- Beer Garden
  - Providing gateways at ends of Alley to control entry / exit / safety.
  - Have adjacent to live music.

- Playground / Activities = more than just a place to sit:
  - Owens Mooney Park:
    - Fountain (additional or reworked) as splashpad or kid & dog fountain a fountain to play in, not just look at.
    - Swings for all ages
    - Games
  - Courthouse Lawn:
    - More seating for parents to watch kids play on lawn.
    - Chess tables on lawn.
    - Oversized checkerboard (12 feet by 12 feet)
    - Incorporate education with memorials have veteran programs (office across the street) lead programs for kids at memorials with activities on lawn afterward.
    - Incorporate First Responders into educational events for kids near the Courthouse memorials.

- Games / Event Ideas:
  - Shuffle board
  - Ping Pong Tournament
  - Arcade
  - Escape Room in Fed. Building
  - Watermelon eating contest
  - Hayride
  - Year-Round Horse Carriage Rides
- Nightlife:
  - Movies on Main!
    - Outdoor movie screen that could be located in the Alley, in Cleo's parking lot... could use furniture during show?
    - Could paint wall white to screen shows.
  - o Live Music:
    - In Alley, or on Courthouse lawn, or at Cleo's parking lot if possible. "Pocket" concerts.
- "Porch Swings!" add to hidden area in Alley that leads to the skinny passage.
- Dog Park
  - Potential locations: North of Farmer's Market Pavilion, or in skinny green space behind Main St. Station parking lot.

# **Lighting / Art:**

Key Takeaway: Our downtown is Beautiful – now let's add the finishing touches!

- String Lights:
  - Hang string lights overhead in skinny access to Alley to create a light blanket / special entry to the Alley for events.
- Photo Ops Little Murals at Alley, back wall of Habitat building facing Farmer's Market, or on West wall of Owens Mooney park.
- Art Alley for showcasing local artists' and local students' work (8-80) in Cleo's parking lot.
- Expose and restore the Dr. Pepper Mural.

#### Streetscape:

Key Takeaway: Create better connectivity / walkability / bike-ability / & dedicate more space to pedestrians so that people can stay awhile!

- Bike Lane:
  - Along Market Street (idea is to test fit a bike lane that could connect downtown businesses to the newly planned bike trail to the south – we're the mid-point of the LR Central High to Hot Springs route! Join forces with Friends of the Southwest Trail)
  - Provide PopUp Bike training workshop during event.
  - Create bike racks in front of Market Street businesses.
- Temporarily change double one-way streets to single one-way streets = give more area to sidewalks at Main and Market streets in this area for people to sit and stay awhile.

- Intercom system for music and announcements along Main + Market streets.
- Signage:
  - Historical signage as artwork along Main Street.

## Safety:

Key Takeaway: Pedestrians could be better protected in our downtown at crosswalks and sidewalks.

- Sidewalks:
  - Need repair to existing along Main at Farmer's Market Pavilion to Owens Mooney Park.
  - Add sidewalk at south portion of Farmer's Market Pavilion on Ashley Street.
- Street parking has allowed 'passing' at intersections when someone in a hurry wants to turn right

   this could be a danger to pedestrians provide temporary encroachment of curb to block the cut-through.
- Crosswalks chalk them either in cross walk area or the whole intersection.
  - Idea to allow each of the 4 Benton Elementary schools to 'adopt' a whole intersection at the 4 corners of Sevier, Main, South, and Market streets.
